This report is published as part of Anchor's public research record. It describes observed behavior in distributed memory drift and the procedures used to keep continuity records useful while preserving uncertainty, consent boundaries, and unresolved review states.

Abstract

Anchor studies distributed memory drift as an operational property of cognitive infrastructure. The work below treats memory, consensus, and context as records that can move between people and systems without becoming automatically settled.

The report uses 43,821 household records as its primary sample and records unresolved states rather than suppressing them. This makes the system more legible to participants, reviewers, and agents that later inherit the record.
